2ND ANNUAL CHILI COOK-OFF

2 OCTOBER, 2010



Set up time: 7-8 a.m. **Location:** East end of the South side of the Exhibition Hall

Start cooking: 8 a.m. All cooking and preparation **MUST** take place on location. Health and Safety Regulations will be enforced (wash basin / soap / coolers for ingredients / fire extinguishers/...). An official start signal will announce the beginning of the competition.

Stop cooking: 10:00am. An official signal will also note the end of the cooking time.

Registration fee: FREE, but registration must be made before 18 Sep 2010 (call 448-4308 or come to the Market).

Judging: Mixed, Official Judging (five community members) and Public Judging

- \$5.00 for **PUBLIC** judging kit (All proceeds to go to the Dundas County Food Bank)
- Judging to take place between 10:00am and 1p.m using blind testing procedures.
- Bowls, cutlery, bread and water will be provided by the organizing committee
- Judges **MUST** evaluate each entry
- Votes to be tabulated by organizing committee and winners announced shortly after 1pm

Rules:

- All contestant entries must be received by 18 September 2010 (contestant list will be located at Exhibition Hall on Fair Grounds)
- Contestants to bring all cooking equipment and ingredients required (propane BBQ, charcoal BBQ pits, electric grills, wood smokers, bourbon, beer, meat, vegetables, chili,)
- Organizing committee will provide access to electricity as required. Electrical cords will not be provided
- All preparation of chili must be done on site and from scratch. "Scratch" means starting with raw meat and using regular spices. All meat must come from an Approved source
- Contestants must be prepared to serve taste size portions (up to ½ cup) to each member of the public with judging kits
- Categories are Regular or Vegetarian
- Teams must have a minimum of 1 entry, but can enter up to a maximum of 3 types of Chili –see *Categoris on registration form*
 - o Mild / Medium / Hot
 - o Beef / Chicken / Pork / Vegetarian
 - o Beans / No Beans

Prizes:

- Best overall Chili - \$100
- 1st (\$25), 2nd (\$15) and 3rd (\$10) Regular Chili
- 1st (\$25), 2nd (\$15) and 3rd (\$10) Vegetarian Chili



(for prizes to be awarded, there must be a minimum of three entries in each category)
