



## MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2010

### NOTICE OF NOMINATION FOR OFFICE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

A person may be nominated for an office in the 2010 Municipal Election by filing in the Office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100.00 for all other offices. The form can be filed in person or through an agent, payable by cash, certified cheque or money order. A nomination form may be filed in the office of the Returning Officer or Designate during the period set out below.

A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent during regular business hours between January 4, 2010 and September 10, 2010, at the Office of the Clerk, 636 St. Lawrence Street, Winchester, Ontario. Nomination papers may also be filed between 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on September 10, 2010 (Nomination Day).

#### **HOW TO BE NOMINATED:**

- Obtain a Nomination Form (Form 1) by clicking [here](#)
- Clearly indicate the name and address of the person to be nominated and all other information required
- A person seeking office must be a qualified elector in the municipality or district school board
- Nomination papers will be received by the Chief Returning Officer or designate as described in this notice

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidates for municipal office must, upon nomination, be a qualified municipal elector and fulfill all of the following requirements:

- A resident of the municipality, a non-resident owner or tenant of land in the municipality or the spouse of such non-resident owner or tenant;
- A Canadian citizen;
- At least 18 years old;
- Not legally prohibited from voting; and
- Not disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office.

**NOTE:** A candidate, if nominated, must remain qualified throughout the election and, if elected, throughout the term of office.

**TO BE ELECTED:**

Mayor – One (1) to be elected at large  
Deputy Mayor – One (1) to be elected at large  
Councillors – Three (3) to be elected at large  
Trustees:

- Upper Canada District School Board (English Public)
- Catholic District School Board of Education (English Separate)
- Conseil scolaire de district catholique de l'Est Ontarien (French Separate)
- Conseil des écoles publiques de l'Est de l'Ontario (French Public)

**PLEASE NOTE:**

Anyone interested in being nominated for **School Board Trustee** for any of the school boards listed above **must present themselves to the Clerk's Office of the Township of South Dundas to file their nomination papers.**
