2019 Dog Tags Are Available

SAVE UP TO 40% by getting your dog tag(s) before April 30th, 2019.

Payments may be made by cheque, cash, credit card, money order, or debit. Residents are reminded that, in accordance with North Dundas By-law 38-2000, all dogs within the Township of North Dundas must have a tag no later than April 30th of each year. Dog tags may be purchased for \$20 each (\$15 for neutered or spayed dogs) before April 30th, or \$30 each (\$25 for neutered or spayed dogs) on or after April 30th, 2019.

Failure to have a dog tag for your dog(s) could result in a fine.

REMINDER, ALL DOGS MUST HAVE A TAG BY APRIL 30, 2019.
