2020-2021 Dog Tags Are Available

SAVE UP TO 25% by getting your dog tag(s) before June 30th, 2020.

Payments may be made by cheque, cash, credit card, money order, or debit. Residents are reminded that, in accordance with North Dundas By-law 38-2000, all dogs within the Township of North Dundas must have a tag no later than June 30th of each year. Dog tags may be purchased for \$40 each (\$30 for neutered or spayed dogs) before June 30th, or \$60 each (\$50 for neutered or spayed dogs) on or after June 30th, 2020.

Failure to have a dog tag for your dog(s) could result in a fine.
