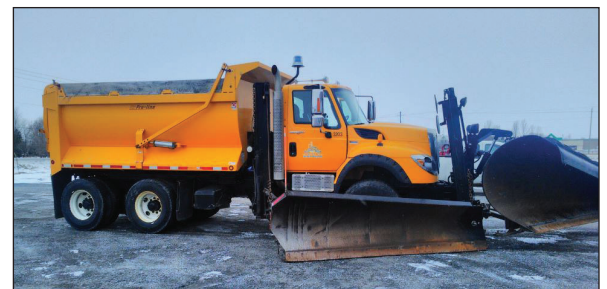
### TRY PICKLEBALL THIS SPRING

### STARTER COMPANY PLUS

The program provides successful applicants with assistance to start, grow or buy a small business. Assistance includes business skills development and mentoring from local business leaders. Participants are eligible to make a pitch to receive a grant of up to \$4,500. Applications open in early April.



### GET YOUR BURN PERMIT

If you are going to be having a brush fire this year, get your \$15 burn permit early. Applications can be found on our website. You can mail us your application with a cheque or submit it by email to [info@northdundas.com](mailto:info@northdundas.com) and then call the office to make your payment. Remember to follow all burning restrictions.

Recreational campfires do not require a permit.
