Buy Your Burn Permits Online

New for 2023, you can now conveniently buy your fire burn permits online at nd.burnpermits.com. Brush fire permits cost \$15 and Agricultural/Land Clearing fire permits cost \$75, both are valid until the end of the calendar year. A permit is required for each property where burning will take place. Be sure to follow all North Dundas Fire Services burn ban notices and keep the community and yourself safe.

Shed Building Permits

Single storey storage sheds that are up to 15m², which are accessory to the principal building, not attached to another structure and contain no plumbing, do not need a building permit. For larger structures, contact our Building Department to obtain a building permit.

Fire Extinguisher Simulator

The NDFS Fire Prevention Committee now has a state-of-the-art training tool that uses digital flames and sensors to demonstrate fire extinguishment techniques. The unit uses hundreds of LED's to show flames growing and diminishing as users attempt to extinguish the simulated fire. Demonstrations will take place at future community events and during their school visits.

North Dundas Community Grant
