

Current Projects



Chesterville Reservoir: The Chesterville Reservoir upgrade project sets out to upgrade the Chesterville drinking water system by increasing storage capacity while also increasing filtration for iron and manganese to help prevent brown water.

Winchester Lagoon: The Winchester Lagoon upgrade sees the installation of a Stimulated Attached Growth Reactor to Cell 5 in the existing lagoon. The SAGR system will increase discharge windows, help the Township meet discharge content requirements, and potentially increase capacity within the lagoon.

Lafleur Road Well: The Lafleur Road Well project will see the installation of two new wells, bringing the total of groundwater wells operating in North Dundas to 8. The additional wells will bring much needed water capacity to North Dundas, so development can continue.
