Buy Burn Permits Online

Brush fire permits are \$15 and Agricultural/Land Clearing fire permits are \$75, which can be purchased online. Permits are valid until the end of the calendar year. A permit is required for each property where burning will take place. Be sure to call the number on the permit before each burn. Follow all North Dundas Fire Services burn ban notices and Open Air Fire Bylaw 2019-41 to keep the community and yourself safe.

North Dundas Community Grant

The Township offers up to five \$400 grants annually for community groups and not-for-profit organizations that request financial assistance to support a community program, event, or beautification effort. Previous recipients have been awarded funds for projects such as a community garden, an



outdoor rink, a message in a bottle fire safety program and promotional signage. Grant application deadlines are April 1st and September 1st.

Reminder of Winter Parking Restrictions

Winter parking restrictions are in effect. No parking is permitted on any street in North Dundas between the hours of 11:00pm and 7:00am from November 1st to April 1st. Restrictions are in place to keep the roadways clear and safe for all travellers.
