What will my Water and Sewer Charges be in 2026?

Service	Charge
Water Consumption Fee	\$1.51 per cubic meter
Water Flat Fee	\$166.56 per year
Sewer Consumption Fee	\$2.75 per cubic meter
Sewer Flat Fee	\$282.48 per year

What will water and sewer cost me annually compared to last year (Based on average household use of 168 cubic meters annually)?

Service	2025 Fee	2026 Fee
Water Consumption Fee	\$236.88	\$253.68
Flat Fee	\$431.76	\$449.04
Sewer Consumption Fee	\$136.60	\$462.00
Total	\$805.24	\$1164.72








Why am I paying more?

- A new rate study in 2025 was completed that identified a necessary increase to the rate in order to accommodate additional system costs due to several factors:
 - o Increased asset management obligations (system is getting older) and building up reserves to pay for aging infrastructure
 - o Increased costs for chemicals and maintenance on equipment
 - o New systems such as the Winchester Lagoon, Chesterville Reservoir, Wellfield 8, and their associated costs

The size of the drop or stream
does not indicate the size of the opening

 ONE DROP PER SECOND	1 Minute Loss = ½ Ounce 1 Hour Loss = 6 Ounces 1 Day Loss = 1 Gal & 1 Pt. 1 Week Loss = 8 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 34 Gallons
 TWO DROPS PER SECOND	1 Minute Loss = ½ Ounce 1 Hour Loss = 20 Ounces 1 Day Loss = 3¾ Gallons 1 Week Loss = 26 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 100 Gallons
 DROPS BREAKING TO STREAM	1 Minute Loss = 2 Ounces 1 Hour Loss = 1 Gallon 1 Day Loss = 24 Gallons 1 Week Loss = 175 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 700 Gallons
 1/16" STREAM	1 Minute Loss = 7½ Ounces 1 Hour Loss = 3½ Gallons 1 Day Loss = 64 Gallons 1 Week Loss = 575 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 2,500 Gallons
 1/8" STREAM	1 Minute Loss = 23 Ounces 1 Hour Loss = 11 Gallons 1 Day Loss = 260 Gallons 1 Week Loss = 1,800 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 7,800 Gallons
 3/16" STREAM	1 Minute Loss = 39 Ounces 1 Hour Loss = 18 Gallons 1 Day Loss = 425 Gallons 1 Week Loss = 3,000 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 12,750 Gallons
 1/4" STREAM	1 Minute Loss = 83 Ounces 1 Hour Loss = 39 Gallons 1 Day Loss = 925 Gallons 1 Week Loss = 6,500 Gallons 1 Month Loss = 27,750 Gallons

Water Pressure – 60 psig

Note: 1 cubic meter = 220 gallons

What can I do to try and lower my bill?

- Look for leaks! A silent toilet leak or a dripping faucet can cost you hundreds of dollars a year

- Be mindful of your usage for example: washing driveways and cars, and watering grass can all add up to an increase in your bill.
